If this occurs, should there be more than one applicant that meets our conditions in the following year, up to two awards may be given out for Weyburn Wildlife Federation Scholarship.

Following Criteria:

- Preference given to individuals attending educational institutes based in Saskatchewan.
- Applicant must be high school students entering post-secondary education.
- Applicant **must** hold a current 2024 Weyburn Wildlife Federation membership or the applicant's parent(s) must hold an active family membership and have history with our organization.
- Applicants **must** include a letter outlining their future education endeavors within the field of interest of the Weyburn Wildlife Federation in conservation, ecology, environmental science, animal sciences, biology, agriculture, or natural resources-based education.
- Applicant **must** be involved in their community, school and have completed volunteer work.
- Letter of recommendation required from any volunteer experience organizer and/or organization.
- Applicant **must** show enthusiasm towards the WWF activities in and around our community.
